The Warrenville Fire Protection District invites all members and the citizens we protect to observe a moment in silence at: **Warrenville Fire Station 1 3 South 472 Batavia Rd, Warrenville, IL 60555 at 7:30 A.M (Central Time).**

Lower flag in remembrance Lower flags to half-staff on the 9/11 anniversary. **Flags may be lowered at 7:46 am (Central Time) to mark the moment when Flight 11 struck the North Tower at the WTC.**

Observe moments of silence. Hold a general moment of silence, or observe multiple moments of silence on September 11 at the following times marking key moments on 9/11. As in years past, these moments will be observed as part of the official 9/11 anniversary ceremony held at the World Trade Center for victims' families. 7:46 am (Central Time): American Airlines Flight 11 strikes the North Tower (1 WTC) 8:03 am (Central Time): United Airlines Flight 175 strikes the South Tower (2 WTC) 8:37 am (Central Time): American Airlines Flight 77 strikes the Pentagon 8:59 am (Central Time) South Tower (2 WTC) collapses 9:03 am (Central Time) (: United Airlines Flight 93 crashes in Somerset County, PA 9:28 am (Central Time): North Tower (1 WTC) collapses.
