



The Warrenville Fire Protection District (WFPD) is looking for individuals to serve on its Board of Fire Commissioners. This 3 person board meets approximately 4 times a year when needed and is responsible for overseeing the hiring, promotion and disciplinary processes for full time firefighters, not including the fire chief. The Fire Commission is guided by Illinois state statutes, the WFPD Collective Bargaining Agreement & WFPD ordinances.

This important job has a huge influence on the day to day operations of the District as well as on the District's future. The ideal candidate would be interested in public service and have some personnel or management experience. Previous firefighting experience or knowledge is not required. Applicants must be 18, live in the WFPD and not be employed by another unit of government. The District includes Warrenville and unincorporated Warrenville south of Mack Road, Arrowhead subdivision in Wheaton, and portions of unincorporated Naperville Township.

The Fire Commission will be appointed by the Board of Trustees and serve a 3 year term. Initial appointments will be for 1, 2, and 3 year terms. A copy of the WFPD Fire Commission ordinance is available at:
