

WFPD TRUSTEE ELECTION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Warrenville Fire Protection District's Board of Trustees is the corporate authority of the Fire Protection District. It has the power to control all the District affairs. It oversees the writing of the tax levy and budget; authorizes purchases of new vehicles and equipment; appoints the Fire Chief; and passes the ordinances that govern the District in order to meet the community's and Fire District needs along with promoting the Fire District in the community.

The Board of Trustees of the Warrenville Fire Protection District hereby announce that three positions of the board of trustees will be up for election at the April 2, 2019 Consolidated Election. The positions shall consist of 1 (full) six year term, 1 (unexpired) 4 year term, and 1 (unexpired) 2 year term in accordance with Illinois law. Please indicate on the Statement of Candidacy the Term being sought. Information for interested nonpartisan political candidates may be found on the website of the Illinois State Board of Elections (www.elections.il.gov) This website includes an 2019 Election Calendar and 2019 Candidates' Guide.

Candidate packets will be made available at the Warrenville Fire Protection District Fire Station located at 3S472 Batavia Road, Warrenville between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. starting on September 10, 2018. By statute, nomination petitions may not be circulated prior to September 18, 2018. Nominating petitions and related documentation will be accepted at this same address from 8:30 a.m. through 5 p.m. on weekdays between December 10-17, 2018.
