

The Warrenville Fire Protection District is seeking applicants to fill a 2-year term on its Board of Trustees (BOT). The five member BOT is responsible for the financial and administrative aspects of the District. Its responsibilities include writing and approving the yearly budget and tax levy; planning and approving purchases; appointing the Fire Chief; determining compensation for District employees; and writing and passing ordinances. The BOT meets on the 3rd Wednesday of every month at 5:00 p.m. at the Batavia Road Fire Station. Applicants and other interested persons are encouraged to attend the BOT's meetings. The 2-year term begins on Monday, May 6, 2019.
