ORDINANCE NO. 01-02

**AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING FEES FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL
TRANSPORTATION OF NONRESIDENTS AND DISTRICT RESIDENTS**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Fire Protection District Act grants to the Board of Trustees of a fire protection district the authority to “fix, charge and collect fees for emergency ambulance service within or outside of the fire protection district” (70 ILCS 705/22); and

WHEREAS, the Warrenville Fire Protection District (“District”), DuPage County, Illinois, is a fire protection district duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the District renders emergency medical services including emergency medical transportation service, collectively referred to as “emergency medical services,” to persons, businesses and other entities in the performance of its obligations to the general public; and

WHEREAS, the provision of such emergency medical services incurs costs to the District and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the District has assessed non-residents of the District with fees for emergency medical services for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, the District requires additional revenues to finance its operations due primarily to the passage of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law; and

WHEREAS, the costs to the District of providing such services has steadily increased over the past several years; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interest of the District to charge both residents and nonresidents for the costs incurred in providing emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to provide emergency medical services at a discounted rate to its residents because residents assist the District’s operations through the payment of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds, after reviewing records of emergency medical responses, that the reasonable cost of providing services per transport is as set forth in **EXHIBIT A** hereto; and

NOW THEREFORE Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Warrenville Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section One: When emergency medical services are rendered by the Warrenville Fire Protection District (“District”) to persons, businesses or other entities who are not residents of the District, such persons, businesses or other entities shall be assessed per response per the fee schedule

set forth in **EXHIBIT A**. Residents shall be assessed a one-time flat fee of \$100 per ALS or BLS call.

Section Two: For purposes of this ordinance, "resident" is defined as someone who permanently resides in the District.

Section Three: All revenue from the charges assessed pursuant to this ordinance shall be deposited in the Ambulance Fund of the District.

Section Four: The Fire Chief is authorized to waive any or all of the fees due from a person, business or other entity under this ordinance. The Fire Chief may do so by policy or on an individual basis.

Section Five: Nothing in this ordinance shall authorize the District to refuse to provide any service to any person, business or entity that has not paid for services previously or that owes any money for services previously rendered.

Section Six: All ordinances and parts or ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent that they conflict.

Section Seven: The invalidation of any section, part, provision, term or phrase of this ordinance shall not affect the validity or invalidity of the remaining sections of this ordinance.


Section Eight: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Board of Trustees.
