

An Ordinance of the Warrenville Fire Protection District

Ordinance #04-04

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION OF PERSONAL
PROPERTY OWNED BY THE WARRENVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, in the opinion of at least a simple majority of corporate authorities of the Warrenville Fire Protection District, it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the Warrenville Fire Protection District, to retain ownership of the personal property herein after described; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined and voted on at the August 9, 2004 Warrenville Fire Protection District Trustee meeting to sell said property at the DuPage Mayors and Managers Conference public auction held on Saturday, September 11, 2004,

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Warrenville Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Board of Trustees of Warrenville Fire Protection District find the following described personal property:

owned by the Warrenville Fire Protection District is no longer necessary or useful to the Warrenville Fire Protection District and in the best interests of the Warrenville Fire Protection District will be served by its sale.

SECTION TWO: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, Captain Herb Myers, as an agent of the Warrenville Fire Protection District is hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned personal property owned by the Warrenville Fire Protection District at the DuPage Mayors and Managers Conference public auction, on Saturday, September 11, 2004 at the College of DuPage, Glen Ellyn, Illinois to the highest bidder on said property.

SECTION THREE: No bid which is less than the minimum bid price set forth in the list of property to be sold as authorized by the Warrenville Fire Protection District Trustees or their agent.


SECTION FOUR: Captain Herb Myers is hereby authorized and may direct the DuPage Mayors and Managers Conference to enter into an agreement for the sale of said personal property. The Conference will charge an administrative fee, which will come out of the proceeds from the sale of surplus vehicle.

SECTION FIVE: Upon payment of the full auction price, Captain Herb Myers is hereby authorized and directed to convey and transfer title to the aforesaid personal property, to the successful bidder.


SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
