

**ORDINANCE NO. 2006-02**

**AN ORDINANCE INCREASING TRUSTEE COMPENSATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Warrenville Fire Protection District is a fire protection district duly organized under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the District also has full power pursuant to 70 ILCS 705/6 to pass all necessary ordinances, and rules and regulations for the proper management and conduct of the business of the Board of Trustees of the District for carrying into effect the objects for which the District was formed; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 6 of the Fire Protection District Act sets forth the compensation that may be paid to the Trustees of the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Trustees of the District have not received any increase in compensation in many years; and

**WHEREAS**, the demands placed upon District trustees have increased over the years; and

**WHEREAS**, the population of the District has increased, the District fire department has become larger and the District has hired several full-time personnel over the past several years; and

**WHEREAS**, because the District has hired more than 4 full-time paid firemen, the Trustees are entitled to receive an increase in compensation to a total of \$2,250 per Trustee per year; and

**WHEREAS**, once the District hires its tenth full-time paid firemen, the Trustees are entitled to be compensated at the rate of \$3,000 per Trustee per year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to increase Trustee compensation that shall take effect for Trustees as they are newly appointed or reappointed to new terms of office with the District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained** by the Board of Trustees of the Warrenville Fire Protection District as follows:

**Section One:** Trustee compensation shall be increased to \$2,250 per Trustee per year. When the District hires its tenth full-time firefighter, Trustee compensation shall be increased to \$3,000 per Trustee per year.

**Section Two:** In compliance with State law, no Trustee may receive an increase in compensation during the length of their term of office. Accordingly, the new Trustee compensation rates shall take effect only for newly appointed or reappointed Trustees beginning on the date of appointment or reappointment.

**Section Three:** That this Ordinance shall supersede any ordinances or motions or parts of ordinances or motions in conflict with any part herein, and any such ordinances or motions or parts of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

**Section Four:** If any section, paragraph or provisions of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section Five:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its date of signing.
