

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WARRENVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT,
DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS,

CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF FULL-TIME FIRE CHIEF

WHEREAS, the Warrenville Fire Protection District presently has no full-time Fire Chief or Fire Fighter, and,


WHEREAS, the Warrenville Fire Protection District is desirous of creating the position of Full-time Fire Chief and Fire Fighter and to retain and employ, on a full-time basis, a Fire Chief of the Warrenville Fire Protection District as an employee of said Warrenville Fire Protection District,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Warrenville Fire Protection District:

1. That there is hereby created the position of full-time Fire Chief of the Warrenville Fire Protection District;
2. That said position of full-time Fire Chief shall be filled by appointment by the Board of Trustees of the Warrenville Fire Protection District and, when so appointed, said appointee shall be, and become, the Fire Chief of the Warrenville Fire Protection District, on a full-time basis, and shall be an employee of the Warrenville Fire Protection District;
3. Upon the appointment of a person to the position of

full-time Fire Chief of the Warrenville Fire Protection District, the Board of Trustees of said Warrenville Fire Protection District shall prescribe the duties and fix the compensation of said Fire Chief, pursuant to Illinois Revised Statutes, Ch. 127-1/2, Sec. 26.
