

ORDINANCE 87-1

ADOPTING WAGE AND SALARY PROVISIONS FOR EMPLOYEES  
OF THE WARRENVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the WARRENVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, DuPage County, Illinois, has determined that it is in the best interests of the District to hire employees on a part-time, on-call basis, for the purposes of greater fire protection, and

WHEREAS, the District intends to establish a wage and salary structure for part-time, on-call firemen, as employees of the District.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the WARRENVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, of DuPage County, as follows:

ARTICLE 1 DEFINITIONS

That "firemen," for the purposes of this ordinance, means a part-time, on-call employee of the District who has been hired by the District to perform fire-fighting duties.

ARTICLE 2 SALARY

The salary for said firemen shall be on a yearly basis in the amount of \$8.00 per call.

The hourly wage to be paid to fireman shall be the amount of \$8.00 per call.

ARTICLE 3 DUTIES

The salary is to be paid for duties involving the normal course of fire fighting, including, but not limited to, fire extinguishment, pre-fire planning, fire prevention and fire investigating.

ARTICLE 4 SPECIAL COMPENSATION

Employees shall receive additional compensation for the following activities: fire fighting training seminars, and special duty. Such special compensation shall be payable at \$8.00 per session.

ARTICLE 5 BONUSSES

The Board of Trustees, at their discretion, may provide monthly or annual bonuses to employees for fire-fighting services rendered above and beyond the duties described in Article 3.

ARTICLE 6 EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect within ten days after publication of this ordinance.
