ORDINANCE AMENDING WARRENVILLE FIRE PROTECTION  
DISTRICT ORDINANCE NO. 94-1

WHEREAS, the Warrenville Fire Protection District has previously adopted a fire prevention code in order to protect its residents from the threat of fire and associated hazards; and

WHEREAS, Fire District Board of Trustees believe, and hereby declare, that it is in the best interests of the Fire District and its residents to supplement the aforesaid code;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Warrenville Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois, has the power to promote and protect the public health, safety, comfort and welfare of its citizens and to require the maintenance of buildings located within its jurisdiction reasonably safe from hazards of fire. ILLINOIS REVISED STATUS, Chapter 127 1/2, section 21.

WHEREAS, the Warrenville Fire Protection District previously enacted Ordinance No. 94-1, an ordinance amending 93-2 Warrenville Fire Protection District Fire Prevention Code on February 14, 1994 requiring installation of a knox box at all commercial properties by 12/31/94.

WHEREAS, the Warrenville Fire Protection District has been unable to secure full compliance with the aforementioned Ordinance No. 94-1; and

WHEREAS, the Fire District Board of Trustees believe, and hereby declare, that it is necessary to impose fines to ensure compliance with Ordinance 94-1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WARRENVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

The following provisions shall be added and incorporated into the Warrenville Fire Protection District Ordinance 94-1:

1. All commercial properties which shall have failed to comply with the knox box requirements set forth in Ordinance 94-1 within ninety (90) days from July 1, 1995, shall be assessed a penalty for noncompliance in the amount of \$25.00 and be assessed a monthly penalty for noncompliance in the amount of \$25.00 per month for any month or partial month of noncompliance thereafter.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be fully in force after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
