

**ORDINANCE NO. 95-5  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 95-1A**

**WHEREAS**, the Trustees of the Warrenville Fire Protection District on the 13th day of February, 1995, adopted General Ordinance No. 95-1A; and

**WHEREAS**, General Ordinance No.95-1A sets forth in Article VI vacation time for 24-hour shift employees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Warrenville Fire Protection District discovered a conflict in the provisions of Article VI with the vacation benefits previously provided to said employees; and

**WHEREAS**, it is desirable to avoid conflict in the ordinances of the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Warrenville Fire Protection District find it necessary to amend General Ordinance No.95-1A to clarify and rectify the conflict as relates to vacation time for 24-hour shift employees.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Warrenville Fire Protection District as follows:

Article VI of General Ordinance No. 95-1A is hereby revoked and rescinded and replaced with the following:

**ARTICLE VI VACATION TIME FOR 24-HOUR SHIFT EMPLOYEES**

After one (1) year	7	duty days
After ten (10) years	9	duty days
After fifteen (15) years	10	duty days

A minimum of two (2) vacation days will be taken at one time.

All vacations for shift personnel who have had at least one year of continuous service, shall be scheduled by December 31st of each year for the upcoming calendar year and all requested vacation periods shall be based upon seniority.

Vacation time earned between the first anniversary date and the start of the next calendar year shall be earned at a rate of 10 hours per month for shift personnel and 6.67 hours per month for weekly members.

This ordinance shall become and be effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
