ORDINANCE NO. 96-2

ORDINANCE AMENDING 90-1 WARRENVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
FIRE PREVENTION CODE

WHEREAS, the Warrenville Fire Protection District has previously adopted a fire prevention code in order to protect its residents from the threat of fire and associated hazards; and

WHEREAS, Fire District Board of Trustees believe, and hereby declare, that it is in the best interests of the Fire District and its residents to supplement the aforesaid code;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Warrenville Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois, has the power to promote and protect the public health, safety, comfort and welfare of its citizens and to require the maintenance of buildings located within its jurisdiction reasonably safe from hazards of fire. ILLINOIS REVISED STATUTES, Chapter 127 1/2, section 21.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WARRENVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

The following provisions shall be added and incorporated into the Warrenville Fire Protection District Board's FIRE PREVENTION CODE:

Section 1: That Section One Warrenville Fire Protection District and Chapter 3 of Title 8, City of Warrenville Ordinance 1106 (Fire Prevention Building Regulations) be and the same is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken words and adding the following underlined words:

- a: Fire Prevention Code 1990 Edition as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators;
- b. The Life Safety Code 1994, edition, published and modified by the National Fire Protection Associations (NFPA No. 101) as amended by Ordinances of Warrenville Fire Protection District;
- c. Volumes one through ~~five, seven, seven~~ and nine through eleven excepting NFPA numbers ~~73, 1001, 1021, 1031, 1041, 1501, 1901, 1921, 1931, 1979, 70~~ and 70B of the National Fire Codes, 1994 edition, published and updated (supplemented and amended) by the National Fire Protection Association.

There shall be three (3) copies of the Fire Prevention Code, the Life Safety Code and the National Fire Codes kept on file for public inspection in the office of the Fire District Clerk.

AMENDMENTS TO LIFE SAFETY CODE: The following sections of the NFPA Life Safety Code, 1994 Edition are hereby revised as follows:

Section 19-3.4 is revised to read as follows:

Section 19-3.4.1 is revised to delete the exception thereto

Section 27.2.4, 27-2.4.2 exception no. 2 is revised to read as follows:

Exception No. 2: Any business occupancy not over one story and not exceeding 1,500 square feet gross floor area per floor may be permitted with a single separate exit to each floor if the total travel distance to the outside of the building does not exceed 100 feet, and the exit is enclosed in accordance with Section 5-1.3 and serves not other levels and discharges directly to the outside; or a single exit shall be permitted if the travel distance to the outside does not exceed 100 feet, and the building is equipped with a complete monitoring fire alarm system.

Section 27-3.1.2 is revised to read as follows:

27-3.1.2 Floors below the street level used for storage or other than business occupancy shall be protected from the spread of smoke. A door with an approved self-closer shall be provided at the top of the basement stairs.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be fully in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT 10 DAYS AFTER PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.
