Duty to Display Information (5 ILCS 140/4)

The Warrenville Fire Protection District (WFPD) is a specialized unit of local government dedicated to fire prevention, suppression, rescue, and emergency medical services. It operates independently from the City of Warrenville and covers an area slightly larger than the city itself. The WFPD also participates in the Mutual Aid box Alarm System (MABAS) to assist and receive support from neighboring fire agencies.
